

TERMS

This Document shall serve as the legal and binding representation of business conduct between the parties and entities named and contained herein for the purpose of the implementation of agreed upon responsibilities and arrangements pursuant to the common success and completion of services outlined.

"Transporter" is defined as person in named in this contract to be transporting of the alpaca(s) listed and shall be known as "Transporter" for the remainder of this contract. "Owner" is defined as person listed on Alpaca Registry Certificate and legally owns alpaca(s) listed in this contract and shall be known as "Owner" for the remainder of this contract. "Client" is defined as the person responsible for payment to the Transporter and shall be known as "Client" for the remainder of this contract. In some cases, the Owner and Client may be the same party.

By signing this contract, Client understands that Transporter is not responsible for any/all liabilities. Client understands and agrees that the Transporter is to provide transport from pickup location to delivery location and will provide adequate service and care, without condition, pursuant to the health and beneficial well-being of the alpaca(s) listed in this contract. Client understands that alpaca(s) to be in Transporter's custody, must have insurance during transport term. Client has the option to self insure. Transporter is no responsible for Veterinary expenses. Transporter agrees to provide adequate feed and facilities for normal and reasonable and routine care required to maintain the health and well-being of the alpaca(s) during transport. "Normal and reasonable and routine care" means the same standard of care currently applied in the management of the alpaca(s) owned by the Transporter. The Client guarantees the alpaca(s) to be in good health with no infections, diseases, or stress related issues. If an issue arises that needs attention, it is the Transporter's responsibility to contact the Client immediately. During the time the alpaca(s) are in the care and custody of the Transporter, Transporter shall not be liable for any sickness, disease, estray, theft, death, or other injury which may be suffered by the alpaca(s) or for any other cause of action arising out of this transport contract. Prior to transport, the Client is required to have all alpacas undertake a full veterinary exam of the alpaca(s), using a veterinarian of the Client's choosing, at Client's expense. Client undertands that the alpaca(s) listed in this contract must be in quarantine for a period of 5 days prior to leaving.

INSURANCE

Owner represents either that the alpaca(s) listed in this contract are insured with a "full-mortality" insurance policy or that the Owner is acting as his own self-insurer, both as to mortality, and also to injury, damage or any event causing a loss of value of alpaca(s) that may occur. The Owner understands to be self insured, means should death occur, Custodian is not to be held liable. for the alpaca(s), listed in this contract. Should alpaca(s) die, Custodian is not responsible to have a necropsy performed. All transportation made by Custodian in the event of death or injury is to be paid by Owner at rates listed in this contract.

HOLD HARMLESS

Client agrees to hold Transporter harmless from any claim resulting from damage or injury caused by the alpaca(s) to any person and agrees to pay any attorney's fees, cost, or expenses incurred in defense of such claims. With the above information agreed upon by the Client, the Client hereby releases Good Shepherd Farm Alpacas from any claim resulting from the loading, unloading and transportation of client's animals.

AUTHORIZATION OF EMERGENCY CARE:

Client authorizes emergency veterinary care. Client agrees to pay (reimburse) all necessary and reasonable veterinary charges for services rendered to the alpaca(s) while in the care of the Transporter. Transporter agrees all attempts will be made to contact the Client prior to, during, and after emergency care.

COSTS OF TRANSPORTATION:

Client responsible for all costs of transportation of the alpacas, including return trip, unless other arrangements have been made and outlined in this contract. Transportation required by Client will incur fees of \$.60 per mile. (Additionally, all expenses related to the trip will be covered by Client, such as tolls, lodging if necessary to stay overnight, meals, etc.) Transporter is scheduled to deliver alpaca in a timely manner. A deposit of 50% is due upon the signing of this agreement. Remaining balance due upon pickup and must be paid via, cashier check, money order, or cash. Due to expenses involved in cancellations, this deposit is refundable only if the Transporter is unable to make the trip as scheduled. Client is responsible for all medical bills, health certificates, non-routine expenses, and travel insurance. In the event that the required paperwork is not available when the transporter arrives to pick up the animals, the animals will not be transported and the deposit will not be refunded.

ENTIRE AGREEMENT:

This is the entire agreement between the parties. All previous discussions and negotiations have been merged into this written contract.

CHANGE OF ADDRESS

Both parties of this contract will notify the other of any change in address during this contract. Required change of address notification requests shall be given for the following: Physical Address, Mailing Address, Email Address, and Telephone Number

LEGAL PROCEEDINGS:

Disputes arising between parties, venue and jurisdiction shall lie within the state and judicial district where the Transporter resides. In addition to legal relief, a court is hereby authorized to grant injunctive, declaratory or other appropriate suitable relief to enforce both the grant and the limitation of warranties and remedies as set forth by this contract. This contract or any wordage contained herein, do not supersede the laws of any local jurisdiction, town, county, state, or federal authority where agreement takes place. In the event of suit or action directly or indirectly out of this agreement, the losing party shall pay the prevailing party's attorney fees and costs of suit, in addition to any other relief granted by the court.

REQUIREMENT OF TIMELY, WRITTEN NOTICE OF CLAIM

No legal proceedings shall be instituted arising out of this contract unless written notice is delivered within 1 month of the date of this agreement, which notice shall specify the grounds upon which parties may assert their claim, and give the other party reasonable opportunity to respond and offer to cure the alleged breach, if appropriate.

TRANSFER OF RIGHTS AND DUTIES UNDER CONTRACT:

The rights and duties under this agreement may not be transferred without written consent except in the case of death of an individual named in this contract. In this event, the rights and duties will be transferred to a legal representative but only while acting within the scope and duties as a legal representative.

CHANGES AND AMENDMENTS:

Good Shepherd Farm Alpacas has the right to make changes to this contract as necessary. Good Shepherd Farm Alpacas will entertain all recommendations, but they must be made in writing and submitted before signing.

CANCELLATION:

All parties named may cancel this contract by adhering to the specifics outlined; If a party does not comply with the rules and regulations of this contract the other party has the right to cancel this agreement by mailing or delivering a written notice of cancellation.
