## Contract for Tag-A-Long Show Program

### Tag-A-Long Program Terms of Service

The Good Shepherd Farm Alpaca's Tag-A-Long Program provides a means for Owners to show their alpacas without the extra expense of travel, dining, and lodging. Owners only additional cost is \$20 per head. Owner is responsible for show entry fees, Vet. Cert. of health for travel and show entry, and any and all veterinary expenses. A fee of \$20 per head will be required in advance. All alpacas must be BVDV neg., be microchipped, and be of age for show entry. All entry fees, stall fees, etc. are to be paid prior to show entry deadline. Veterinary Certifications are to be dated within 30 days of the show date. Copies Show Entry forms, BVDV results, blood test, Permission to Show, Vet. Cert. of Health, and any other forms required for show entry and travel are to be sent to Good Shepherd Farm Alpacas 10 days prior to show date. Owner agrees to award Handler 10% commission on all sales made at the show. Owner is defined as party recognized as legal owner of the alpaca by the Alpaca Registry and will be name "Owner" for the remainder of this document. Handler is defined as party in custody of the alpaca(s) during transport to and from the show and, during the show and will be named Handler for the remainder if this document.

**SERVICES TO BE PROVIDED:**

Handler agrees to provide adequate feed and facilities for normal and reasonable and routine care required to maintain the health and well-being of the animal(s) during the period of time alpaca(s) are in custody and care of the Handler. "Normal and reasonable and routine care" means the same standard of care currently applied in the management of the alpacas owned by the Handler.

**Services included at no additional charge to Owner:**

- \* Halter Class Showing
- \* Marketing
- \* Individual Attention
- \* Feed, Hay, and Water
- \* Electrolytes
- \* Halter training
- \* Record Keeping
- \* Personal Pictures from show
- \* Show Updates
- \* Show Program (If available)

**Services included with additional charge to Owner:**

- \* Alpaca shearing is the responsibility of the Owner. If shearing is to be done at the show, Owner is responsible for all shearing cost.
- \* All medicating such as Probios, Gastrogard, eye drops, topical antibiotics, de-worming, etc. can be administered for the cost of the medication, plus a \$5.00 administration fee per application.
- \* All alpacas arriving or returning to Good Shepherd Farm will be in isolation for five days while deworming takes place for a fee of \$5.00 per application plus medication.

**OWNER RESPONSIBILITIES**

Please Note: Handler recommends that the Owner have as much hands-on interaction as possible prior to show. Handler requires that all alpacas, arriving on the farm and/or traveling in trailer, are in good health with no parasites, infections, diseases, or stress related issues. If an issue arises that needs attention, it is the Handler's discretion to remove the alpaca(s) and treat as necessary. All Alpacas traveling with and/or boarding at Good Shepherd Farm must be tested negative for BVD prior to arrival. BVD (PCR or VI) negative test for all alpacas will be required for entry on to Good Shepherd Farm property. Owner must have test results included on Veterinary Health Certificate. Boarder agrees to pay veterinary and lab fees for test and transportation fees. Owner must provide Agistor with a copy of alpaca registration. Owner is responsible to pay Handler for Veterinary services, medication, treatment, etc. due to injury, illness, infection, etc. inflicted upon Handler's alpacas that originate from Owner's alpacas. Owner is required to supply halters and leads for their alpacas. Handler can supply halters at a cost of \$15 and leads at a cost of \$10.

**WAIVER OF LIABILITY:**

During the period the alpacas are in the care and custody of the Handler, Handler shall not be liable for any sickness, disease, estray, theft, death, or any other injury which may be suffered by the alpacas or for any other cause of action arising out of this contract.

**BOARDER TO INSURE OR SELF-INSURE:**

Owner represents either that the alpaca(s) are insured with a "full-mortality" insurance policy or that the Owner is acting as self-insurer, both as to mortality, and also to injury, damage or any event causing a loss of value of alpacas that may occur. Owner further agrees to sole remedy, in the event of damage, loss, or any event causing a loss of value to male, dam, or cria at her side, shall be to make claim against any insurance policy that is acquired. If Owner fails to acquire such insurance, and hence act as his own self insurer, he shall be deemed to have waived any claim against Handler both as to mortality, and also as to any injury, damage or any event causing loss of value of alpacas that may occur. Owner will abide with the alpacas Mortality insurance contract requirements and conditions.

**COMMUNICATION:**

Handler requires Owner to return contact to Handler within 4 hours upon initial contact. Issues may arise that Handler may need to contact Owner due to health, breeding, payment, etc. Failure to contact Handler within the 4 hour period will result in an additional fee of \$10 per hour including first 4 hours.

**HOLD HARMLESS:**

Owner agrees to hold Handler harmless from any claim resulting from damage, injury, or death caused by the alpacas to any person or property and agrees to pay any attorney's fees, cost, or expenses incurred in defense of such claims.

**AUTHORIZATION OF EMERGENCY CARE:**

Owner authorizes emergency veterinary and agistor care and agree to pay all necessary veterinary charges for services rendered to the alpacas while in the care of the Handler. All attempts will be made to contact Owner prior to, during, and after emergency care to keep Owner informed.

**COSTS OF TRANSPORTATION:**

Handler is responsible for all costs of transportation of the alpacas to and from the Show site. Owner is responsibly for transportations from Owner's farm to the Handler's farm. Arrangements can be made to pick up alpaca(s) on the way to the show. Owner is responsible for any and all off route travel to show. Off route transportation required for Owner's alpacas will incur fees of \$.60 per mile and \$10.00 per animal. (Additionally, all expenses related off route travel will be the responsibility of the Owner, such as tolls, lodging if necessary to stay overnight, meals, vehicle rental etc.) If off route travel is required by multiple Owner's, the costs will be shared equally amongst the Owners. When Fuel prices are at and above \$2.80 per gallon, an additional charge of \$10 per hour.

**SALE OF AGISTED ALPACAS:**

Handler agrees to represent all contracted alpacas to potential buyers at Owner's request. A 10% commission of the sale price will be earned and payable to the Handler upon the sale, during or 3 months after show, of any fully owned contracted alpaca, if the Handler locates the buyer.

**NONASSIGNMENT:**

The warranties and remedies under this contract are non-assignable and inure only for the personal benefit of the Handler. The warranties and the remedies shall be void and lapse in the event of any sale or transfer of any interest (including transfer of part ownership) in the animal.

**ENTIRE AGREEMENT:**

This is the entire agreement between the parties. All previous discussions and negotiations have been merged into this written contract. This Document shall serve as the legal and binding representation of business conduct between the parties and entities named and contained herein for the purpose of the implementation of agreed upon responsibilities and arrangements pursuant to the common success and completion of services outlined.

**CHANGE OF ADDRESS**

Both parties of this contract will notify the other of any change in address. Required change of address notification requests shall be given for the following; Physical Address, Mailing Address, Email Address, Telephone Number, Employer name, address, telephone number, fax within 10 days of address change.

**ATTORNEY FEES:**

In the event of suit or action arising directly or indirectly out of this agreement, the losing party shall pay the prevailing party's attorney fees and costs of suit, in addition to any other relief granted by the Court.

**LEGAL PROCEEDINGS:**

If any disputes arise between the parties, venue and jurisdiction shall lie with the state and judicial district where Handler resides. In addition to legal relief, a court is hereby authorized to grant injunctive, declaratory or other appropriate suitable relief to enforce both the grant and the limitation of warranties and remedies as set forth by this contract. This contract or any wordage contained herein, do not supersede the laws of any local jurisdiction, town, county, state or federal authority where agreement takes place.

**REQUIREMENT OF TIMELY, WRITTEN NOTICE OF CLAIM**

No legal proceedings shall be instituted arising out of this contract unless written notice is delivered by Owner to Handler within 1 months of the date of this agreement, which notice shall specify the grounds upon which Owner assert their claim, and give Handler reasonable opportunity to respond and offer to cure the alleged breach, if appropriate.

**BENEFICIARY / TRANSFER OF RIGHTS AND DUTIES UNDER CONTRACT:**

The rights and duties under this agreement may not be transferred without written consent except in the case of death of an individual named in this contract. In this event, the rights and duties will be transferred to the beneficiary listed in this contract while acting within the scope and duties as a legal representative. Until a legal representative is appointed, party having proper temporary custody of the contracted alpaca(s) will have the same rights and duties, but only with respect to those contained herein.

In the event of the Owner death or becomes incapacitated, the Handler is to transfer the ownership of the alpacas listed in this contract to the following person(s). By assigning a Beneficiary, Owner transfers authority to transfer to Handler. Proof of identification is required. Failure to name beneficiary will forfeit ownership to Handler.
